## Review of the year:

At the BSA Conference 2014 the Realism Study Group organised a Theory Stream Plenary where Professor Margaret Archer spoke on 'Morphogenesis Unbound: Critical Realism and Changing Society' which was very popular. There was also a Realism and Social Research session within the Theory stream at the 2014 conference with 5 speakers.

We will continue to work with the Theory study group to include a session on realism in the Theory stream at the BSA conference. Unfortunately neither convenor is able to attend the 2015 BSA Conference due to lack of institutional funds at their respective universities to support conference attendance.

The Realism Study Group continues to hold occasional events to provide a forum for sociologists with an interest in realism to meet and discuss current issues. This year we are planning to hold a joint session with the BSA Bourdieu study group to develop further theoretical analysis and understanding between Bourdieu and realism in debates around structure and agency, social constructionism, power, the nature of knowledge claims and critique.
