ABSTRACT REVIEW AND SELECTION PROCESS

The Programme Committee will blind review the abstracts.

All abstracts will be reviewed independently by two members of the Programme Committee for their relevance to the sociology of health and medicine. The following criteria are used to assess and score abstracts:

RELEVANCE - Is the proposed paper relevant to medical sociology?

CLARITY OF PURPOSE - Is the purpose of the proposed paper clear, be it theoretical/conceptual development and/or presentation of empirical research?

RIGOUR re: METHODS - Does the proposed paper offer precision with regard to methodology used, be it theoretical/conceptual development and/or empirical paper?

Before the decision to exclude an abstract is taken, the Programme Committee will check to ensure that non-UK, first time and postgraduate submissions are considered sympathetically.
