



Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts should be submitted via the BSA's online abstract submission process.

Oral Papers (250 word count limit)

The programme coordinators will allocate Oral Paper slots after consideration of all accepted abstracts, together with the keywords supplied by authors. All oral presentations will be 30-minute papers so you should plan to speak for 20 minutes and allow 10 minutes for comments and questions.

Special Panel (500 word count limit)

Special Panel sessions are 1.5hr sessions. Please submit your Special Event on the BSA website by choosing your preferred presentation mode from the dropdown menu as 'Special Event'. You will need to select one person to submit **all** papers within your panel, please do not submit panel papers as individual oral presentations.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ABSTRACT (ORAL PAPERS)

The presenting author should complete the online submission form. You will need to log in or register in order to submit an abstract.

- Visit the [BSA events website](#), find **BSA SocRel Annual Conference 2020: Celebrating SocRel at 45: Beyond Binaries in the Sociology of Religion** and click 'Submit Abstract' on the right hand side of the page.
- You will be prompted to log in or register. Once logged in the abstract submission form will automatically appear. Complete the form as appropriate.
- Submit your abstract on the submission page.

You can review your abstract, save it and revisit at a later stage. You can check your MyBSA area under Abstract Submission Details to view the progress of your abstract.
