

BSA Leisure and Recreation Study Group Annual Report for 2022

Throughout 2022 we (along with Gökben Demirbas) have prioritised the completion of the editing of a Special Issue of *Annals of Leisure Research* based upon the Study Group's online event "Leisure for All: Formulating the Right to Leisure as a Radical Demand for Democratic Citizenship", held on 21 January 2022. Six of eight articles comprising the Special Issue are contributed by presenters at that event, and have been complemented by two further articles on related themes. The two co-convenors and Study Group member Gökben Demirbas will contribute an overview/introduction for the Special Issue; following the appearance of the Special Issue, there is also the likelihood that it could be republished in book form by Taylor & Francis/Routledge. We will emphasise the contribution of the BSA and the Study Group in making this project possible and internationally prominent.

We are planning to hold a Study Group meeting online in the Autumn of the current calendar year (2023) to develop a programme of further themes and topics that members would like to address, and to bring the group members together at a live event now that the BSA's London room is once more available. We will thus seek to reactivate the full membership of the group over the forthcoming couple of years.
