## **Review of the year:**

• The study group convened and chaired the majority of the WEEL streams at the BSA virtual annual conference 2024. The theme of this session was: 'Crisis, Continuity and Change.'

• The co-conveners are in regular contact including scheduled Zoom meetings.

• We have set up a WEEL Reading Group to engage and motivate study group members in regular discussion of related scholarly articles, to share ideas and to network and explore potential collaborations. There was a strong response from WEEL group members to the invitation, with 65 members subscribing to the Reading Group.

• WEEL are in the process of taking over the X (formerly Twitter) account to increase its followers as well as to promote the BSA and establish links with other BSA study groups.
