Posters (250 word count limit)

The poster presentation format is a dedicated slot in the conference programme where presenters are invited to speak to conference delegates about their work and gain feedback.

Poster presentations are an ideal opportunity for those who are more comfortable with visual presentation methods to present preliminary work or to display complex findings. Poster presentations allow delegates more time to study and reflect on the work, often resulting in thought-provoking questions and comments.

Poster presenters will be provided with a space on a display board. Further details of the location and time of the poster presentation will be communicated prior to the conference.

Please display your poster, and any leaflets you have produced, as soon as you arrive at the conference. Posters **must** be in place 45 minutes before the dedicated poster session, and where possible they should remain on display for the duration of the conference.

You are responsible for displaying your poster and removing it after the conference. Posters should be secured to the display boards using Velcro strips (hooks). Places on display boards will be allocated by the Conference Organisers.
