The BSA Science and Technology Studies (STS) Study Group is looking for a third co-convenor. The group is currently led by Dr Alina Geampana (Durham University) and Dr Yuhan Wang (Bath Spa University).

This is a valuable opportunity to help shape the direction of the group, support its members, and contribute to building an active and inclusive space for research, dialogue, and collaboration.

The co-convenor role entails:

- Sharing relevant information and events with members using the jiscmail list
- Organising occasional events/workshops
- Managing the group's budget
- Liaising with the BSA
- Representing the study group at BSA Study Group meetings
- Organising streams and plenaries for the BSA annual conference, as well as conference chairing

In the coming academic year, we are keen to continue a regular programme of events including a seminar series and professionalization talks aimed at early career academics. This will include inviting speakers and liaising with relevant parties to plan event budget, promotional materials and practical arrangements.

Working as a convenor for the group does not require a heavy time commitment, and the position is open to senior, mid or early career academics and PhD students in their final stages of study. We would ideally like the new convenor to start in November 2026. Please note that convenors must be BSA members and maintain their membership for the duration of their tenure in the role.
